The value set originated as a set of values to complete the UB-04 claim form indicating one of the following items:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – y = yes (i.e., the diagnosis is present on admission) – n = no (i.e., the diagnosis is not present on admission) – u = unknown (i.e., it is not known if the diagnosis was present on admission) – w = undetermined (i.e., the clinicians cannot determine if it was present on admission) – 1 = unreported/not used (basically indicating the diagnosis is exempt from reporting but the form does not allow a blank so guidance suggests entering a “1” in the form) |

| | | | <p>The Value Set Authority Center (VSAC) does not include this value set. It is available in HL7 as an example value set (http://hl7.org/fhir/R4/valueset-ex-diagnosis-on-admission.html). QI-Core is required for the QI-Core extension <u>encounter-diagnosisPresentOnAdmission</u>. However, the HL7 value set does not include the code "1". Note that the value set was created for the <u>Claim.diagnosis.onAdmission</u> element by the Patient Administration Workgroup. There are several factors requiring resolution to get this value set into VSAC and they will take considerable time to resolve. Therefore, an eCQM CQL expression has no value set to reference, and no direct reference code from that value set to reference for specific retrieve requirements. A possible interim solution for measures requiring evidence, absence or exemption from presentOnAdmission is to represent the desired values in the CQL expression by using text (i.e., for measures seeking POA of yes, the CQL expression representation is "y"). ESAC asked vendors whether it is possible to map to evidence of POA using text if a CQL example is provided.</p> <p>Joe Kunisch (Memorial Hermann) noted POA indicator is consistently captured as a yes/no. The claims coders easily extract this information for all patients regardless of payer. He is in favor of including this text option because it will solve problems with trying to determine POA through other proxy measures. He noted POA is determined by the coding department through physician documentation. Marilyn Parenzan (TJC) noted during a virtual visit with a hospital and she observed a process to import a diagnosis into the clinical EHR with a column for POA and Y, N and E for exempt. The reason is that this indicator is a required field on the claim. Mia Nievera (TJC) suggested there remains an issue with QRDA I parsing text rather than a code from a code system. While clinically feasible; the QRDA I IG indicates that coding is required. TJC tried using text but could not use a string in QRDA I. Paul Denning (MITRE) noted Standard for Trial Use (STU) comments were entered for the QRDA I standard regarding the POA indicator as the mapping reference indicated the discharge status value set. The comment was resolved indicating correction in the next version and potential errata for the current version. However, the possibility of using a text (string) rather than a value set remains an issue.</p> <p><u>Resolution/Next Steps:</u> Vendor feedback indicated this presentOnAdmission data is available. An issue remains with QRDA I parsing the data as text. The ESAC team will review with the QRDA team to determine how and when this can be addressed.</p> |
