



The MC Workspace brings together a set of interconnected resources, tools, and processes to promote transparency and better interaction across stakeholder communities that develop, implement, and report electronic clinical quality measures (eCOMs).



MC Workspace Components

The MC Workspace is comprised of three modules to assist clinicians, eCOM developers, implementers, and submitters during the entire eCOM Lifecycle, from initial measure concept, through development, implementation, and reporting to CMS. Goals of the MC Workspace are to

- Provide detailed data element definitions to support implementation
- Achieve harmonization across measures, data elements, and value sets
- · Improve alignment of measure concepts with clinical need and newly published guidelines



Electronic Clinical Quality Measure (eCQM) Concepts

The Measure Collaboration Workspace Electronic Clinical Quality Measures (eCOM) Concepts module gives users the ability to search for eCOM concepts suggested by others and comment on those suggested eCOM concepts, submit new eCOM concepts, describe the population(s), and assign a care setting. There are hyperlinks to the CMS Measures Inventory Tool (CMIT) and the National Quality Forum's (NOF) Quality Positioning System (QPS) to help identify whether similar eCOMs already exist. Feedback provided through the eCOM concepts Module can help guide a measure developer to refine the concept and purpose behind a new eCOM and develop detailed specifications to meet the needs of targeted quality measurement stakeholders.

How to Comment on or Suggest an eCQM Concept

If you have an eCQM concept in mind or want to comment on an eCQM concept someone else has suggested, follow these simple steps to propose your idea:

- 1. Search the <u>CMS Measures Inventory Tool</u> to see if your suggested eCOM concept is in progress or already exists.
- 2. Review the list of suggested eCQMs, click the name of the concept of interest to see if the details of the suggested concept are similar to your
- idea for an eCQM. If yes, it is similar, offer comments to the submitter in the Add new comment box.
- 3. If no, suggest your eCQM concept by clicking Suggest an eCQM Concept and fill out the form.

MC WORKSPACE – CONCEPTS - DISCUSSION

- Where do you go to look for and review new measure concepts?
 - CMS and Fed Register
 - Payer data on what they are requesting for value-based care, etc.
 - CMS CMIT
 - NCQA measures
 - I don't go at all; I just work on what's already required
 - CMS MUC list
 - Received an email back in the spring about MUC so did check that out when I received it
 - CMS proposed rule and MUC
 - Quality Net email notifications on upcoming measures



MC WORKSPACE – CONCEPTS - DISCUSSION

 Sounds more like new ideas for measures. A measure concept could have been like "initial population concept", denominator exception concept, stratification concept. The name "ecqm concepts" did not resonate with me as a place to look for and propose new measure ideas.

The eCQM Testing Opportunity module provides stakeholders with available opportunities to participate in eCQM testing. Measure developers use testing for a variety of reasons throughout the Measure Lifecycle. They need pilot sites to

- assess measure feasibility
- determine the extent to which the required data elements are available and retrievable in the electronic health record/health information technology
- · determine the extent to which measured entities can implement without undue burden for performance measurement
- assess measure reliability
- assess measure validity
- reassess after updating specifications
- assess measure usefulness

- Test site staff will gain insight into quality measurement that could help your organization refine its internal efforts to improve quality.
- Test site staff will help provide insight for a measure that CMS may use in its quality reporting programs.
