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1 Introduction – Dos and Don'ts for Referencing eCQMs

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) developed this terminology document to provide guidance for common words, phrases, technical terms, and file formats used in conjunction with electronic clinical quality measures (eCQMs).

eCQMs quantify and measure aspects of quality in our health care system by measuring the performance of hospitals, clinicians, and other measured entities who provide health care services.

Whenever possible, the guidance in this document should inform the publication of eCQMs and supporting materials by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) agencies and other federal health partners using eCQMs in their quality programs. eCQM publication vehicles include, but are not limited to:

- Proposed and final rules
- Public Comment webpages
- Websites
- eCQMs and supporting files
- Communications
- Education and outreach materials

Terminology alignment is important to advancing the CMS goal of reducing burden on interested parties implementing eCQMs. Use this terminology guide to promote clear and consistent publication of eCQM terms.

Note: National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) has an extensive <u>Document Drafting Handbook</u> addressing publication requirements for all U.S. government agencies. If there are any differences between this terminology document and the Document Drafting Handbook, the NARA document overrules. Additionally, CMS requests the use of 'health care' rather than 'healthcare' in CMS communications.

2 General eCQM Terminology

2.1 Electronic Clinical Quality Measure

An electronic clinical quality measure (eCQM) is a measure specified in a standard electronic format that uses data electronically extracted from electronic health records (EHR) and/or health information technology (IT) systems to measure the quality of health care provided. eCQMs include data elements, logic, and definitions in a Health Level Seven International® (HL7®) standard, which represent a clinical quality measure in an electronic document that can be captured, stored, shared, and read electronically.

Table 1 presents correct and incorrect references for eCQMs.

2.2 CMS eCQM Identifier

The CMS eCQM identifier is a unique number with a version number to indicate the published version of the eCQM. The correct terminology for the unique identifier is **CMS eCQM ID**. Table 2 shows the correct and incorrect eCQM ID references.

2.3 Use of CMS eCQM Identifiers

There are multiple private and public references identifiers for eCQMs, such as the Consensus-Based Entity (CBE) ID, the CMIT Measure ID, the Measure Set (MS) ID, and the Program ID. The CMS eCQM ID should always be published when referring to eCQMs used in federal quality reporting programs. Whenever possible, refrain from creating new eCQM reference identifiers and use the CMS eCQM ID. Table 3 presents the correct and incorrect eCQM identifiers.

Table 3. Use of eCQM Identifiers

Note: The CMS eCQM ID is required to be present in a machine-readable format when sending CMS eCQM ID information to any CMS website, e.g., eCQI Resource Center, for posting.

2.4 eCQM Elements Published in Tables

There are many publication elements that may be published in conjunction with eCQMs. These elements include, but are not limited to:

- Full eCQM Title
- Short eCQM Title
- CMS eCQM ID
- Program/Quality ID
- CMIT Measure ID
- CBE ID
- Cascade of Meaningful Measures Priority and/or Goal
- Measure Set ID
- Measure Type
- Steward
- Description
- Initial Population
- Numerator
- Denominator

Rules and/or educational materials may require, recommend, or make optional the elements noted in Table 4 when publishing tables with eCQMs. CMS recommends the first column contain the CMS eCQM ID and the second column include the full eCQM title.

2.5 Format for Listing eCQMs by Reporting/Performance Year

The format for listing the eCQMs for quality reporting for eligible hospitals (EHs), Outpatient Quality Reporting (OQR), and/or eligible clinicians (ECs) should include a reference to the reporting or performance period. Use the format: {Year} {Performance or Reporting} Period {Eligible Party} eCQM.

Please note eligible clinician and eligible hospital should only be abbreviated when referenced in filenames, pick lists, and publication tables that are character limited. Table 5 presents the correct and incorrect formats for eCQM reporting/performance year references.

2.6 eCQM File Formats and Versioning

Technical eCQM filenames are machine-readable and must remain consistent from update to update to ensure easy consumption and comparison by various tools, resources, and EHRs. Use the filename formats noted in Table 6 and Table 7 when naming and publishing eCQMs and supporting materials.

Measure developers are to submit measure materials files to the eCQI Resource Center for eCQM Annual Update publication without a version indicator. A version indicator such as v2, v3, v4, etc. is only used when a file is updated after the current corresponding Annual Update is published and before the next Annual Update is published. Note: the version indicator is for the name of the updated specification zip files and resource file names only.



Note: The filename year is to reflect the reporting/performance year the file contents are to be used for.

2.7 Corrections to Files within Zip Files

If the content of a published zip file needs correcting, measure developers are to include an indictor of the correction on the components of the file which were corrected. Ex: CMS15611-v2.zip XML corrected.



2.8 eCQM Data Element Repository (DERep)

The eCQM Data Element Repository (DERep) provides additional clarification for all the data elements associated with published eCQMs used in CMS quality reporting programs as well as the definitions and clinical focus for each data element. There are other data element repositories in use by CMS and other federal health agencies. Be sure to use eCQM whenever referencing the eCQM DERep. Table 8 presents the correct and incorrect references for the eCQM Data Element Repository.
